1. Welcome and introductory remarks by Chair

Dr. K. D. Ladva, welcomed the august body and informed following:

• NAAC A&A Cycle-3: In response to the letter written by the college regarding validity period of NAAC Cycle-2 accreditation considering Covid-19 pandemic; NAAC office have clarified vide letter no. NAAC/Covid-Ext./BSP/2021 dated 07/12/2021 following: The validity period of the Cycle-2 accreditation stands extended with the existing 'A' grade with 3.28 CGPA till the completion of the 3rd Cycle A & A Process "provided the college submits the online IIQA within three months from the resuming of the normal academic activities as per the Government / University notification.



As per the NAAC notification dated 7th Dec. 2021; the college has submitted AQAR's for A.Y. 2018-19 & 2019-20 on NAAC HEI portal before 31/12/2021; and have also made minor improvements/corrections as per NAAC email dated 03/01/2022. The online AQAR submission for A.Y. 2020-21 is in progress & will be made before last date 31st Jan. 2022.

- SSIP: The College has signed MoU with Gujarat Knowledge Society (GKS) for Gujarat Government Scheme of Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP) 1.0 and received grant / financial support for the period of 2018-21. The GKS has sanctioned Rs. 5.0 lakh and have released Rs. 1.97 lakh. The college has successfully completed SSIP grantee evaluation by Government auditors on 29th & 30th November 2021.

 Government of Gujarat has extended the period from 2022-2027 for new policy recognized as SSIP-2.0.
- Innovation Club: Department of Higher Education, Government of Gujarat has launched a scheme Innovation Club in December 2021; the college has formed innovation club and submitted consent letter to CHE, Gandhinagar on Cogent Portal dated 23/12/2021.

 Salient features of Innovation club:
- Uplift research and innovation in Gujarat by igniting Technical and Non technical students in the field of research and Start ups.
- Students will be trained for Blocked Based Coding (Total 15 Online modules will be taught to the students in every week for 1.5 hrs)
- Students will also be trained for Sensors, Smart Devices and by DO-It-Yourself DIYkit provided to the institution
- Students can develop proto types or model based on their ideas

Dr. Sheela Ramachandran suggested that NAAC is going to revise its procedure and its manuals and it's likely to be more Outcome Based and Impact Based. Therefore, it is suggested to prepare a draft SSR. She urged the college should concentrate in bidding for award like IIC and ARIIA.

Dr. Ladva informed that the college has already started collecting data for the same and will also start in parallel activities for preparation of IIQA, draft SSR, GSIRF & NIRF-2022. Dr. Ladva informed the dynamic improvements in the NAAC AQAR data templates and also

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acknowledged the user friendly. He also assured that the college will participate in bidding for award in IIC as well as ARIIA.

Dr. Ladva informed that the college keeping in mind the protocol book of CoE has always declared result before 20 Days from the last semester end examination.

bound academic event calendar encompass the learning capabilities of the students as well as their assessment irrespective of the challenges we all are facing. She has proposed two suggestions. Firstly, let us not try to delay the completion of the examination of final year students. It should not be delayed beyond the month May. Secondly, the college should take care that all the students must give all components of assessment. Even though presence of students in assessment & evaluation is 95% but then take follow up of remaining 5% students. Find out the reason for their inability for the same whether it is corona or unable to access the technology. She suggested that the members of Academic Council should take a decision that such students must be given a second chance. We must enable every single students to attend all the component of assessment & evaluation and to complete the program successfully. She urged that the Academic Council must give authority to the Principal to take the decision regarding how to enable such students this time as well as year to come till the pandemic persist and report back it back in the next meeting.

Dr. Ladva informed that the college has taken every step to complete the academic events as per Academic Calendar. He informed that the college has conducted survey of the students regarding COVID-19 pandemic and found that the 5% students who have been not able to



attend the assessment and evaluation is only due to the COVID-19 pandemic, they have also submitted their medical reports for the same. He also informed the body that department wise and program wise mentors are in continuous contact with the parents and the students.

4. Issuance of Final Degree Certificate to B.Voc. and 5 Years Integrated Programs:

Dr. Ladva informed the august body the following:

The college have introduced following integrated programs from A.Y. 2016-17 as per the UGC's guideline for Autonomous College.

- 5 Years Integrated B.Sc. M.Sc. Microbiology
- 5 Years Integrated B.Sc. M.Sc. Mathematics
- 5 Years Integrated B.Sc. M.Sc. Chemistry

After getting recommendations / approvals from the BoS, AC and GB of the college; the affiliating Saurashtra University have been informed **before A.Y. 2016-17 admission** and have submitted the program wise list of candidates admitted along with necessary documents for verification to the University.

As per the requirement of the degree convocation the O.R. of the successful candidates who have taken exit at the end of 3rd year; have been submitted in prescribed format of Saurashtra University. Accordingly the University has issued provisional degree certificates to the students of 2016-19 and 2017-20 batches; but the final degree still awaited.

In response to the follow-ups taken by the college; Saurashtra University vide its letter no. AK/1040/2021 dated 22/12/2021; have informed that the issuance of final degree certificates agenda will be put up in the next ensuing senate meeting of the University schedule on 01/02/2022 for the approval.

In response to the follow-ups taken by the college; Saurashtra University vide its letter no. AK/1040/2021 dated 22/12/2021; have informed that Academic section have forwarded the recommendations of Dean, Faculty of Science to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Saurashtra University for appropriate guidance/direction and approval.

Dr. Sheela Ramachandran urged that this Academic Council is only for the Autonomous College, therefore for the batch of 2015-2018 batch which comes in non-autonomous status, so in that this august body does not have any say. For that the Principal has to write a separate letter to the Saurashtra University and then take necessary follow ups. She asked the Principal that aforementioned programs have been discontinued from 2018-19 & onwards. The Principal confirmed the closure of all 5 Years Integrated B.Sc. - M.Sc. programs and also all B.Voc. programs under DDU KK; from 2018-19 & onwards as per resolution made in the Governing Body of the college.

In response to the query raised by Dr. Sheela Ramachandran; Dr. Ladva, informed that all the students have opted voluntarily for exit at the end of 3rd Year in all 5 Years Integrated programs and will get degree of B.Sc. Chemistry, B.Sc.-Microbiology and B.Sc. Mathematics respectively. The said resolutions were passed by the BoS and Academic Council of the college.

She emphasized that on the basis of strong recommendation of this august body, the Principal should write a follow up letter to the Saurashtra University regarding issuance of the degree.

Dr. Sheela Ramachandran suggested that the college should continue and confirm to schedule the meeting of Academic Council soon after the completion of a semester and before the commencement of next semester for the sake of not only stating what has been done for getting recommendations but it is also to do gap analysis and improvement strategies.

She suggested two agendas which will be the expectation of reporting in future - First, the outcome & impact of the Result Analysis and ATR and Second, the feedback on teacher's performance with ATR and its outcome. Also to upload on institutional intranet for reference and improvement, this is also important from NAAC point of view. The Principal replied that the department is conducting their monthly departmental meeting in which they discuss and prepare ATR based on result analysis including remedial coaching conducted and its impact.

She asked the Principal to identify one or two Resource Persons for (1) Generation and

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validation of MCQ for preparation of Question Bank for Concept Recapitulation Test (CRT) and (2) for assessment of attainment of course outcome through feedback questionnaires along with the marks at the end of each course. This will also become one more model of feedback mechanism towards attainment of course outcome similarly attainment of program specific outcome and program outcome at the end of the program. She suggested to conduct a HoD council internal meeting for discussion & finalization of the vertical/tracks for DSE cluster & TDE cluster in light of NEP-2020 aspiration.

The above was seconded by Dr. Sameer K. Vaidya.
